What's been happening in school?

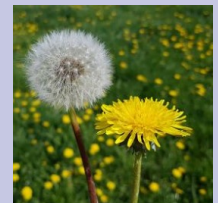
In our assemblies this week we continued listening to stories on the theme of being responsible.

Reception

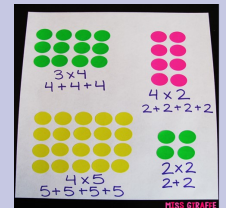
