The exhibition opens today and will be open at the following times:




What's been happening in school?

Reception

This term's theme for our Reception children is 'Splish, Splosh, Splash'. They have been listening to the story of 'Billy's Bucket' by Kes Gray and Garry Parsons. This is the story of a boy who wants one thing for his birthday - a bucket. Inside it, he can see all kinds of magnificent sea creatures. But Mum and Dad are sceptical, and when dad unwittingly uses the bucket to clean his car, he's in for a big surprise!

The children have been imagining that they have a bucket like Billy and have been thinking about what they would find in the bucket and learning to write a sentence about 'what is in my bucket?'

In maths they have been learning how to recognise the number 11 using number shapes and the ten frame. They have been looking at the number 12 too and learning to predict what might come next.

Our year 1 children have had a fantastic first week back at school, they have been recapping what they learnt about castles last term, and thinking about what information they would like to know about castles. This has developed their ability to compose questions and also prepare them for their visit to Tamworth Castle today. The Tamworth Castle trip was a huge success and the children really enjoyed dressing up as medieval knights and also going up the tower!

Year 2 have been developing their reading comprehension skills and applying their Maths knowledge to solve a range of problems. Their topic for this term is 'Living Things and Their Habitats' compare objects that are living, dead and those that have never been alive. Their classrooms have also been filled with the dulcet tones of 'Three Blind Mice' as the children have enthusiastically been practicing with their recorders. In our teacher led PE sessions they have been attacking and defending skills.
