The theme for assemblies this week has been Shrove Tuesday and Lent and our Shine Brightly Theme this week has been Be Your Best.

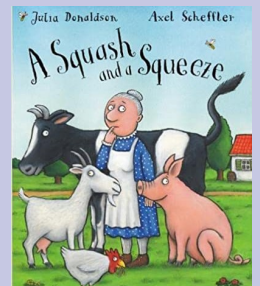
Reception
