## Healthy Fortnight

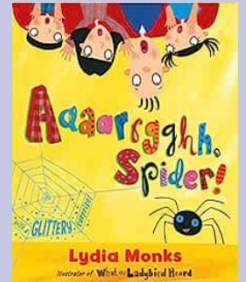

## What's been happening in school?

In our assemblies this week, we have been learning about ...

### Reception

Our reception cohort have been learning about minibeasts this week and as part of that topic they also took a trip to White Post Farm. They also encountered a range of different animals around the farm including goats, insects, reptiles and rabbits and guinea pigs. They had a wonderful day out and we would like to extend a big thank you to all of our amazing parent and carer volunteers!



They have also been learning about spiders and have read several books in class including 'Little Miss Muffet' and 'Aaaarrgghh Spider!'. The children enjoyed a Peter Pan workshop provided by Perform For Schools drama group.

### Yr1

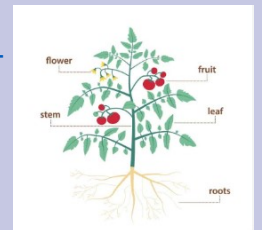
The children in year one have been continuing their theme of animals by learning about mammals and writing a page for a non-fiction book about mammals. In science they have also been identifying and naming a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals and describing and comparing the structure of these animals.



### Yr2

Our Year two children have been studying nonsense poetry this week, writing silly sentences, jokes and humorous rhymes using devices such as alliteration, onomatopoeia, puns and word play. This is to develop their creative and imaginative language skills.

They have also been observing how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants and looking at what conditions plants need in order to grow healthily including light, water and a suitable temperature.
