Champion Passport and Rewards

To celebrate our champions, we have launched the **Champion Passport**:

- Children collect stickers for demonstrating champion behaviours
- Milestones are rewarded with badges.
- The scheme encourages consistency, effort, and personal growth.

How the scheme will work

When the children have displayed characteristics of any of the Champions they can get a sticker from an adult in school. They need to collect a certain amount of each of the WBIS Champions.

In Reception they have to collect at least 1 of each of our champions.

In Year 1 they have to collect at least 1 of each of our champions and some of them twice.

In Year 2 they have to collect at least 2 of each of our champions.
