Our Learning

What has been happening in school?

In Reception: Classes 1, 2 & 3

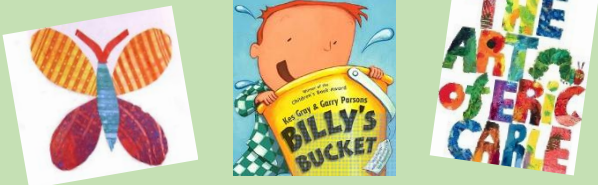
The children's topic has been all about water and learning about where water comes from. They have read the book 'Billy's Bucket' and have produced some brilliant writing about what items were in the bucket. In PE they have been practising over arm throwing skills (as well as all the Health & Sports Week activities). In Maths, they have started learning how to write a number sentence. The children have continued to make repeating patterns in squiggle while you wiggle.

In Year 1: Classes 4, 5 & 6

In English, the children have been reading animal poetry. In Maths they have been learning to add coins together and looking at real money. In Art, the children have been creating some Eric Carle inspired animal collages, painting and cutting out shapes to create their own animal pictures. The children have learnt lots about reptiles in science and have written more of their own fact files.

In Year 2: Classes 7, 8 & 9

Year 2's have been practicing their singing ready for their Leavers concert. The children have created some wonderful writing using lots of different types of punctuation. Their writing has retold the story about the Koala who could. In Science they have planted seeds and bulbs and will be monitoring and watching them grow (making sure they have plenty of water). In Maths they have been learning about missing number sentences in addition and subtraction.

Wow what a week it has been! The children have been fantastic at adapting to the many changes this week. All the sports providers have worked incredibly hard throughout the heatwave to provide a safe, adapted, and fun-filled week of learning and activities for all the children.
