

# Drawing

## RECEPTION

Develop good control of a range of drawing tools.

Begin to explore a variety of drawing materials.

Explore mark making skills using lines, curves and shapes use these to represent objects.

Begin to show some understanding of basic observation.



## YEAR 1

Explore and develop mark making skills using a variety of drawing materials.

Explore and develop observational drawing skills.

Understand what texture means. Use lines and marks while drawing to create different textures, e.g. wood, brick, tiles.

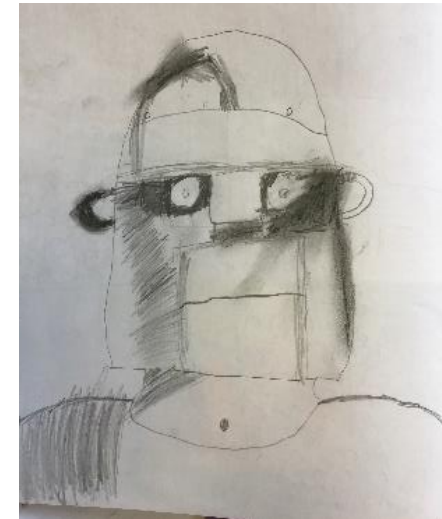


## YEAR 2

Draw objects from observation, memory and imagination.

Explore and know how to create light and dark tones using a variety of drawing materials.

Continue to develop applying pattern and texture in drawing and using it for a purpose.



# PAINTING

## RECEPTION

Develop good paintbrush control

Use paint to create recognisable simple representations.

Explore colour mixing techniques.

Know how to select colour for a purpose.



## YEAR 1

Understand what a primary colour is (colours that can't be made by mixing other colours).

Name and recognise primary colours and experiment with mixing them to discover secondary colours.

Know what warm and cool colours are.

Use and experiment with a wider range of paints for different purposes (e.g. watercolour for background washes).



## YEAR 2

Revisit colour mixing and understand relationships of primary and secondary colours.

Explore how to make colours lighter and darker. (tints and shades)



# PRINTMAKING

## RECEPTION

Explore printing with a variety of materials experimenting with design, colour, pattern, shape and texture.



## YEAR 1

Explore simple printmaking techniques such as rolling, pressing, stamping and rubbing using a variety of materials.

Use printing to create compositions.



## YEAR 2

Explore polystyrene printing and simple mono printing techniques.

Use printing to create pattern.



## 3D

### RECEPTION

Explore stamping, cutting and printing into modelling materials such as clay and plasticine and begin to create basic shapes.



### YEAR 1

Shape and model materials for a purpose from observation and imagination.

Explore different ways of joining materials to form sculpture.

Use clay for a purpose and create patterns and texture in it.



### YEAR 2

Design and create sculpture using a range of media.

Use different ways of joining materials to form a sculpture.

Know how to mould, form shape, bond and smooth Clay to create a 3D form.



## COLLAGE

### Reception

Select and explore a variety of materials, experimenting with colour, design and texture.

Explain the process they have used.



### Year 1

Explore colour, shape and composition.

Select and use appropriate materials to make an image and give reasons for their choices.



### Year 2

Continue to select and use appropriate materials to create textures and design and give reasons for their choices.

Use collage with other disciplines such as drawing, printmaking and making.
