<p>Bed Warming pan</p> 	Used to heat beds before people had central heating in their bedrooms and houses.
<p>Wash Dolly</p> 	Used to help wash clothing before people had washing machines in their house.
<p>Chamber Pot</p> 	Stopped people from having to use the outdoor toilet at night time.
<p>Tin Bath</p> 	Could be moved near the fire to help keep the water warm.
