

Using a Web Browser



I can navigate a website by:

- Clicking on arrows 1 2 3 ... 17
- Searching menus
- Clicking on hyperlinks

Key Vocabulary

Refresh – Reload the internet page

History – Previously visited websites, saved to your web browser

Hyperlink – A link to a new web page. This could be a picture or text that is able to be clicked on.

Website – A group of pages of information

Shortcut – A saved web page that you can get to without typing in the full website

Favourite – A list of saved shortcuts

Tabs – Multiple web pages loaded within your internet browser

Address Bar – Where the website address is typed

M

Don't Meet Up

Accepting Files


Accepting emails, files, pictures or texts from people you don't know can cause problems.

Tell Someone
