### Key

- Website** – A group of pages of information.
- History** – Previously visited websites, saved to your internet browser.
- Search engine** – a program that helps you find websites and web pages.
- Shortcut** – A saved web page that you can get to without typing in the full website.
- Favourite** – A list of saved shortcuts.
- Tabs** – Multiple web pages loaded within your internet browser.
- Address Bar** – Where the website address
